- Updates on conference kick-off:
  - SATURDAY, Oct 15th, 3-7pm @ Gallery H at Thresholds, 3208 n Sheffield, Chicago
  - Will display art from community and art from violence art-making and have space for more art-making -- Kassie will follow up on whether or not to put out call for art. Work from domestic violence sites may have more art.
  - No space to invite community
