Northwestern- October 22nd

They are unable to confirm in writing ahead of time; the costs are: \$300 for forum room- not free b/c we are an outside organization \$225 per day for each additional breakout room (or \$100 per 3 hours) \$45/hr for equipment

Tech support form outlines additional costs- can share at board meeting Space is not best suited for our needs- carpeting, no sinks, no place to eat.

Adler- October 29th?

Backup location: Community Room that seats up to 154, use of other breakout rooms including 2 rooms designed for art therapy; all rooms are Smart rooms with Smart boards, potentially can have their fee (\$1000 per day plus internal costs such as security and IT support) waived.

October 22nd will not work for Adler, because that is the weekend of commencement (which would potentially keep many Adler faculty and students from attending, regardless of where we have the conference).

We explained that the stipend we provide would cover airfare as well. She is interested in staying with friends. We explained to Judy that we need to settle other factors (i.e. location and cost thereof) and bring these items to the board before confirming, and that we will contact her as soon as we are prepared to move forward.
